Entry deadline: January 15, 2002. Entry form must be *received* in Wallingford by this date with the entry fee. Late entries may be refused.

Entry fee: \$35.00; non-members of USSRA add \$10 playing fee. All checks payable to *Choate Rosemary Hall*, please. Players receive souvenir T-shirt.

- The Tournament Committee reserves the right to limit entries if draws become too large. Age group divisions may be combined in the event of insufficient numbers.

- All flights will include consolation draws. Players guaranteed at least two matches; most will play more.

How to get to the tournament:

Driving from the south: Take I-91 north to exit 14 (Woodhouse Avenue). Take a left at the bottom of the ramp and proceed straight through two lights onto East Main Street. The second stop sign thereafter is the intersection of Christian Street; make a left to get to the Choate campus. Make another left onto the driveway across from the Paul Mellon Arts Center, an imposing gray edifice; the Johnson Athletic Center is over the bridge, the first building on the left. Or, if you're heading north on Rte. 15 (Wilbur Cross Parkway), take the first Wallingford exit (#64), make a right at the end of the ramp, head into town by bearing left where the road forks. After you pass the railroad station and head uphill on Center Street, you will cross Main Street (the intersection where the Post Office is) and then make a left at the next traffic light onto North Elm Street. Proceed to the first stop sign, make a right onto Christian Street and then make the first possible right onto Gunpowder Creek Drive; as you proceed down the driveway, you will cross a bridge and find the Johnson Athletic Center on the left.

Driving from the north: Take I-91 south to exit 15 (Route 68). Make a right at the end of the ramp and proceed west on Rte. 68 to the fourth traffic light. Make a left onto North Farms Road. Go straight through several stop signs as North Farms Road becomes North Elm Street and you will find yourself in the middle of the Choate Rosemary Hall campus. Make a left at the intersection of Christian Street and then take the first right; as you proceed down the driveway, you will cross a bridge and find the Johnson Athletic Center on the left.

Via rail: Amtrak serves Wallingford with regular train service daily from the Northeast Corridor. Call 800-USA-RAIL for schedule and ticket information. The Choate Rosemary Hall campus is one mile—a short walk or cab ride—from the Wallingford train station.
